## **Guidelines**

We will strive to have PPE personal protective equipment) at the different events, but it is recommended to bring your own sanitizers, nitrile gloves (multiple pairs), masks, disinfecting supplies, and any other PPE you may need or want.

Please make sure to bring a small trash bag to collect your used PPE and other trash for the safety of others. Please do not leave trash for the autocross committee or volunteers to deal with. If you are seen leaving trash behind for others to deal with you may be asked to leave, and not be allowed back for the remainder of the year.

We also need to communicate that we will be following all local COVID-19 guidelines which requires social distancing of a minimum of 6 ft from persons outside of your household. Most club activities that happen are outside and do exhibit over than average social distance in nature. When indoors and when the social distance rule is not able to be followed, it is recommended by the CDC, State, and County to wear a mask.

Masks are recommended and if you are categorized as a high-risk individual based on the state guidelines below, please refrain from attending this event.
