

Houston BMWCCA Autocross 2020 Supplemental Rules

Please stay home if you are sick, are having symptoms of being sick, or do not feel well. If you appear to be sick, you may be asked to leave for the safety of others around you. You must bring **YOUR OWN** sanitizers, nitrile gloves (multiple pairs), masks, disinfecting supplies, and any other PPE (personal protective equipment) you may need or want. Please make sure to bring a small trash bag to collect your used PPE and other trash for the safety of others. Please do not leave trash for the autocross committee or volunteers to deal with. If you are seen leaving trash behind for others to deal with you may be asked to leave, and not be allowed back for the remainder of the year.

Community beverage coolers and water **WILL NOT BE PROVIDED** at our AX events for the remainder of 2020. We ask that all drivers bring their own coolers, drinking water, and snacks.

Please limit in-person contact with the committee and volunteers supporting our events and maintain the appropriate distance between one another. We hope to restore the social aspects of our AX events soon, but for the remainder of the 2020 season we will need to follow these new guidelines.

Loaner helmets will not be provided for the remainder of the 2020 season as we cannot ensure driver's safety between run groups.

In all likelihood, in-car instruction and ride-alongs will not be available at our remaining 2020 events. You must wear a mask and respect social distancing when communicating with your driving instructor or the rider in your vehicle.

We ask that if you come to one of our events for the remainder of 2020, you have some autocross experience, this is due to the guidelines we have in place.

Finally as a reminder your comfort level may greatly differ from other drivers, and it some case it may very well be the same. In any case we do not want anyone to feel uncomfortable, anxious, or nervous when they come out to race. So always be cautious and aware of your surroundings at all time.

Registration

- Assuming it is available, we will have hand sanitizer at the registration table. Please sanitize your hands before and after registering.
- All participants should assume registration materials including pens are contaminated and should act accordingly. You are asked to wear a mask to register.
- Participants will take their own maps and wristbands from their respective clipboards to limit direct contact with registration personnel.

Workers

Houston BMWCCA will provide sanitizing supplies for timing tent workers to wipe down timing equipment and work areas and nitrile gloves for all workers. Corner Captains will be asked to sanitize the equipment they came in contact with before coming in after heats this includes fire extinguishers, flags, and radios. Grid workers, flagger, and starter will be asked to sanitize the radios and if a vest is used to place into a designated bag to be washed before the next event. Equipment will be pre-sanitized but workers may use our supplies to do it themselves as an extra precaution.
